“Embracing the cross of Infertility” Dr. Marie Meaney

Are you suffering with Infertility?Are you having a hard time dealing with it? Are friends and family hurting more than helping you? Do you feel pressure from them or the culture at large to use methods such as in vitro fertilization (IVF)? Bearing the Unbearable: Coping with Infertility and Other Profound Suffering

Bearing the Unbearable contains reflections and contemporary applications of the struggles with infertility experienced by biblical couples, particularly the patriarchs and matriarchs and the parents of important characters such as Samson, Samuel, and John the Baptist. Using the process of lectio divina combined with reflection questions and parallels with contemporary infertility challenges, the reader is drawn into the biblical text and into a dialogue with God and others, especially their partner. A detailed table of contents and numerous sub-headings allow the reader to identify sections of particular interest. Bearing the Unbearable also addresses other forms of intimate suffering and shows how these are related in the Bible and in life to the trauma of infertility.
